Dear Parade Participant,

Thank you for submitting an application to participate in the annual Parade hosted by the Ridgewood Fourth of July Celebration, Inc. Your application has been accepted and we look forward to your entry in our 112th celebration: **“LET FREEDOM RING”**

PARADE IS MONDAY, JULY 4, 2022

- Each Line-up Division is comprised of similar groups (floats, bands, fire departments, etc.)
- There are no pre-assigned positions within most Divisions -- the order of the parade is set on a rotating basis from each of the Divisions -- the earlier your group arrives, the closer to the front of the parade you will be.
 - NOTE: Groups may begin to line up at any time on the day of the Parade, but must have actual members of the group in place and may not use place holders such as cones, barricades or vehicles other than those used in the Parade.
- FLOATS MUST BE IN PLACE AND READY FOR JUDGING BY 8:00 AM.
 - NOTE: All float personnel do not have to be in place for judging, photographs from a dress rehearsal are acceptable.
- ALL GROUPS MUST HAVE THEIR FULL COMPLIMENT IN PLACE BY **9:00 AM.**
- Please carry a lead banner or have signs on each side of car identifying your group for the audience, judges (sitting throughout the Parade route) and very importantly -- the grandstand announcer.
- All Parade Regulations will be enforced, please review and share the enclosed copy with the members of your group.
- **THE PARADE BEGINS PROMPTLY AT 10:00 AM -- RAIN OR SHINE.**

The committee members of the Ridgewood Fourth of July Celebration, Inc. hope that you and the members of your group enjoy being part of our Parade. Your participation makes the day special for the many people celebrating Independence Day in Ridgewood.

DIRECTIONS TO LINE-UP AREA

These directions do not show the most direct route, instead they are carefully planned to avoid unnecessary traffic in and around the Line-up Areas. **If you are “local”, please check to find the point where you can join in and follow along to the correct Line-up Area.**

MUSIC DIVISION

(on Madison Place)

From Rt. 17:

- Take Linwood Avenue “RIDGEWOOD” Exit
- At second light, turn right onto N. Pleasant Avenue
- Stay on N. Pleasant until road ends, about two blocks
- Turn left onto E. Glen Avenue
- You will pass:
 - One traffic light at N. Maple Avenue
 - One blinker at Oak Street
- At second blinker, turn left onto Heights Road
- Stay on Heights until road ends about 4 blocks
- Buses, turn left onto Madison Place and drop off personnel
- Floats, turn right and join the line-up.

From Rt. 208:

- Take Goffle Road “Midland Park Ridgewood” Exit
- Stay on Goffle Road for about 2 miles
- At second light, turn right onto Godwin Avenue
- Make an immediate left onto Erie Avenue
- Stay on Erie Avenue for about 1 mile (you will pass one blinker)
- Turn right onto W. Glen Avenue (Parkwood Deli is on far corner)
- You will pass one traffic light at N. Monroe Street
- At blinker, turn right onto Heights Road
- Stay on Heights until road ends about 4 blocks
- Buses, turn left onto Madison Place and drop off personnel
- Floats, turn right and join the line-up.

To End of Parade from Line-up Area (for Parking and Pick-up):

- Stay on Madison Place until road ends about 2 blocks
- Turn left onto Crest Road (note – after you pass the “view” area, road curves left – be sure to turn right to continue on Crest Road)
- At stop sign turn left onto Heights Road
- At blinker, turn right onto W. Glen Avenue
- You will pass:
 - One blinker at Oak Street
 - One traffic light at N. Maple Avenue
- Turn right onto Northern Parkway (first right after traffic light at N. Maple Avenue)
- Stay on Northern Parkway for 1 ½ blocks
- Turn right into parking lot
